Mr. SCOTT of Florida (for himself, Mr. TUBERVILLE, and Mr. JUSTICE) introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Banking, Housing, and Urban Affairs

A BILL

To prohibit United States persons from engaging in financial
transactions with AliPay.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “No AliPay Act of
5 2025”.

6 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON USE OF ALIPAY.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—A United States person may not
8 conduct a financial transaction with AliPay (China) Inter-
9 net Technology Company Limited (referred to in this Act

1 as “AliPay”), including by using any application or pay-
2 ment processing service operated by AliPay.

3 (b) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:

4 (1) FINANCIAL TRANSACTION.—The term “fi-
5 nancial transaction” means—

6 (A) a transaction that in any way or de-
7 gree affects interstate or foreign commerce—

8 (i) involving the movement of funds
9 by wire or other means; or

10 (ii) involving one or more monetary
11 instruments; or

12 (B) a transaction involving the use of a fi-
13 nancial institution that is engaged in, or the ac-
14 tivities of which affect, interstate or foreign
15 commerce in any way or degree.

16 (2) UNITED STATES PERSON.—The term
17 “United States person” means—

18 (A) a national of the United States;

19 (B) an alien lawfully admitted for perma-
20 nent residence;

21 (C) an entity organized under the laws of
22 the United States or under the laws of any ju-
23 risdiction within the United States (including a
24 foreign branch of such an entity); or

- 1 (D) an individual who is physically present
- 2 in the United States.
