Mr. CORNYN (for himself and Mr. KELLY) introduced the following bill; which
was read twice and referred to the Committee on Armed Services

A BILL

To promote recruiter access to secondary schools.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. RECRUITER ACCESS TO SECONDARY SCHOOLS.**

4 Section 503(c)(1)(A) of chapter 31 of title 10, United
5 States Code, is amended—

6 (1) by amending clause (i) to read as follows:

7 “(i) shall provide military recruiters the same
8 access to the campus of each secondary school
9 served by the local educational agency for the pur-
10 pose of recruiting students who are at least 17 years
11 of age that is provided to any prospective employer,
12 institution of higher education, or other recruiter;”;

1 (2) in clause (ii), by striking “provide to mili-
2 tary recruiters access to” and inserting “facilitate
3 upon request made by military recruiters for military
4 recruiting purposes not fewer than four in-person re-
5 cruitment events per academic year, across different
6 grading periods, which may include”; and

7 (3) by amending clause (iii) to read as follows:

8 “(iii) shall provide to military recruiters within
9 60 days of the commencement of the academic year,
10 and thereafter within 30 days of a recruiter request,
11 access to secondary school student names, academic
12 grade, addresses, electronic mail addresses (which
13 shall be the electronic mail addresses provided by
14 the school, if available), and telephone and mobile
15 phone listings, notwithstanding subsection (a)(5) of
16 section 444 of the General Education Provisions Act
17 (20 U.S.C. 1232g).”.
