Mr. DAINES (for himself, Mr. RISCH, and Mr. MURPHY) introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Finance

A BILL

To authorize the extension of nondiscriminatory treatment (normal trade relations treatment) to products of certain countries.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. TERMINATION OF APPLICATION OF TITLE IV**
4 **OF THE TRADE ACT OF 1974 TO PRODUCTS OF**
5 **CERTAIN COUNTRIES.**

6 (a) PRESIDENTIAL DETERMINATIONS AND EXTEN-
7 SION OF NONDISCRIMINATORY TREATMENT.—Notwith-
8 standing any provision of title IV of the Trade Act of 1974
9 (19 U.S.C. 2431 et seq.), the President may—

1 (1) determine that such title should no longer
2 apply to a covered country; and

3 (2) after making a determination under para-
4 graph (1) with respect to a covered country, pro-
5 claim the extension of nondiscriminatory treatment
6 (normal trade relations treatment) to the products
7 of the covered country.

8 (b) TERMINATION OF APPLICABILITY OF TITLE
9 IV.—On and after the effective date under subsection
10 (a)(2) of the extension of nondiscriminatory treatment to
11 the products of a covered country, title IV of the Trade
12 Act of 1974 (19 U.S.C. 2431 et seq.) shall cease to apply
13 to the covered country.

14 (c) COVERED COUNTRY DEFINED.—In this section,
15 the term “covered country” means any country excluding
16 Belarus, Cuba, and North Korea.

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
