A BILL

To amend title 18, United States Code, to update the juvenile transfer for criminal prosecution process, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Violent Juvenile Of-
5 fender Accountability Act of 2025”.

6 **SEC. 2. TRANSFER FOR CRIMINAL PROSECUTION OF CER-**
7 **TAIN JUVENILE OFFENDERS.**

8 Section 5032 of title 18, United States Code, is
9 amended by adding at the end the following:

1 “Notwithstanding any other provision in this section,
2 criminal prosecution of a juvenile in the appropriate dis-
3 trict court of the United States may be begun without a
4 motion to transfer of the Attorney General if the juvenile
5 is 16 years of age or older and is alleged to have com-
6 mitted—

7 “(1) any crime of homicide under chapter 51;

8 “(2) aggravated assault, as described in section
9 111(b);

10 “(3) theft of a motor vehicle under section
11 2119;

12 “(4) robbery under section 1951, to which sec-
13 tion 924(c) applies; or

14 “(5) aggravated sexual abuse under section
15 2241, to which section 924(c) applies.”.
