Mr. SCOTT of South Carolina (for himself and Mr. WARNER) introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Finance

A BILL

To provide for the inclusion of virtual diabetes prevention program suppliers in the Medicare Diabetes Prevention Program Expanded Model, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Promoting Responsible
5 and Effective Virtual Experiences through Novel Tech-
6 nology to Deliver Improved Access and Better Engage-
7 ment with Tested and Evidence-based Strategies Act” or
8 the “PREVENT DIABETES Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. INCLUSION OF VIRTUAL DIABETES PREVENTION**
2 **PROGRAM SUPPLIERS IN MDPP EXPANDED**
3 **MODEL.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—For the period beginning on Jan-
5 uary 1, 2026, and ending on December 31, 2029—

6 (1) an entity may participate in the MDPP by
7 offering only MDPP services via distance learning or
8 online delivery modalities if such entity meets the
9 conditions for enrollment as an MDPP supplier;

10 (2) if an entity participates in the MDPP in the
11 manner described in paragraph (1), in the case of
12 online MDPP services furnished by such entity to an
13 MDPP beneficiary who was not located in the same
14 State as the entity at the time such services were
15 furnished, the entity shall not be prohibited from
16 submitting a claim for payment for such services
17 solely by reason of the location of such beneficiary
18 at such time; and

19 (3) no limit is applied on the number of times
20 an individual may enroll in the MDPP.

21 (b) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:

22 (1) MDPP.—The term “MDPP” means the
23 Medicare Diabetes Prevention Program (as such
24 term is defined in section 410.79(b) of title 42, Code
25 of Federal Regulations).

1 (2) REGULATORY TERMS.—The terms “distance
2 learning”, “MDPP beneficiary”, “MDPP services”,
3 “MDPP supplier”, and “online” have the meanings
4 given such terms in section 410.79(b) of title 42,
5 Code of Federal Regulations.

6 (3) SECRETARY.—The term “Secretary” means
7 the Secretary of Health and Human Services.

8 (c) IMPLEMENTATION.—Notwithstanding any other
9 provision of law, the Secretary may implement this section
10 by program instruction or otherwise.

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
