A BILL

To amend the Civil Rights Act of 1964 to improve prohibitions on discrimination by public accommodations.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Defeat Sharia Law
5 in America Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. DISCRIMINATION.**

7 Section 201(a) of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 (42
8 U.S.C. 2000a(a)) is amended by adding at the end the
9 following: “An establishment covered by this section that
10 provides goods, services, facilities, privileges, advantages,

1 or accommodations by implementing Sharia law shall be
2 considered to be discriminating or segregating on the
3 ground of religion under this subsection.”.
