A BILL

To direct the Comptroller General of the United States to conduct a study that identifies options to remove barriers and improve housing for persons who are elderly or disabled.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Improving Housing
5 Access Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. IMPROVING HOUSING FOR THE ELDERLY AND DIS-**
2 **ABLED.**

3 The Comptroller General of the United States shall,
4 not later than 1 year after the date of the enactment of
5 this section, conduct a study that identifies options to re-
6 move barriers and improve housing for persons who are
7 elderly or disabled, including any potential impacts of pro-
8 viding capital advances for—

9 (1) the program for supportive housing for the
10 elderly under section 202 of the Housing Act of
11 1959; and

12 (2) the program for supportive housing for per-
13 sons with disabilities under section 811 of the Cran-
14 ston-Gonzalez National Affordable Housing Act.

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
