A BILL

To reinforce the Foreign Corrupt Practices Act of 1977 by establishing a limitations period of 10 years for antibribery offenses, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. LIMITATIONS FOR ANTIBRIBERY OFFENSES.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding section 3282(a)
5 of title 18, United States Code, no person shall be pros-
6 ecuted, tried, or punished for any offense under section
7 30A of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (15 U.S.C.
8 78dd–1) or section 104 or 104A of the Foreign Corrupt

1 Practices Act of 1977 (15 U.S.C. 78dd–2, 78dd–3) unless
2 the indictment is found or the information is instituted
3 within 10 years next after such offense shall have been
4 committed.

5 (b) APPLICABILITY.—Subsection (a) shall not apply
6 to any offense committed during the period ending on the
7 date that is 5 years before the date of enactment of this
8 Act.

9 (c) SUNSET.—This Act is effective beginning on the
10 date of enactment of this Act and ending on the date that
11 is 8 years after that date.

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
