## A BILL

To repeal section 122 of the Trade Act of 1974 relating to balance-of-payments authority.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “Reclaim Trade Powers  
5       Act”.

6       **SEC. 2. REPEAL OF BALANCE-OF-PAYMENTS AUTHORITY.**

7       (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 122 of the Trade Act of  
8       1974 (19 U.S.C. 2132) is repealed.

1       (b) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The table of contents  
2 for the Trade Act of 1974 is amended by striking the item  
3 relating to section 122.

4       (c) CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—Section 127(b) of  
5 the Trade Act of 1974 (19 U.S.C. 2137(b)) is amended,  
6 in the matter preceding subparagraph (A), by striking  
7 “(and from any action under section 122(c))”.
