Ms. MURKOWSKI introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

To exempt public school employees from non-processing related fees for H-1B visas imposed by Presidential Proclamation 10973.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EXCEPTION TO NON-PROCESSING RELATED**
4 **FEE FOR H-1B NONIMMIGRANTS WHO WILL**
5 **BE PUBLIC SCHOOL EMPLOYEES.**

6 In addition to the exceptions set forth in section 1(c)
7 of the Presidential Proclamation 10973 (90 Fed. Reg.
8 46027; relating to restriction on entry of certain non-
9 immigrant workers), which was issued on September 19,
10 2025, petitions filed on behalf of aliens entering the

1 United States as nonimmigrants to perform services in a
2 specialty occupation described in section
3 101(a)(15)(H)(i)(b) of the Immigration and Nationality
4 Act (8 U.S.C. 1101(a)(15)(H)(i)(b)) and who will be
5 working for a public school or a public school district in
6 the United States shall not be required to be accompanied
7 or supplemented by the payment of \$100,000 otherwise
8 required under section 1(a) of such Proclamation.

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
