A BILL

To amend the Dingell-Johnson Sport Fish Restoration Act with respect to sport fish restoration and recreational boating safety, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Sport Fish Restora-
5 tion, Recreational Boating Safety, and Wildlife Restora-
6 tion Act of 2026”.

1 **SEC. 2. REAUTHORIZATION OF DINGELL-JOHNSON SPORT**
 2 **FISH RESTORATION ACT.**

3 (a) DIVISION OF ANNUAL APPROPRIATIONS.—Sec-
 4 tion 4 of the Dingell-Johnson Sport Fish Restoration Act
 5 (16 U.S.C. 777c) is amended—

6 (1) in subsection (a), in the matter preceding
 7 paragraph (1), by striking “2026” and inserting
 8 “2031”; and

9 (2) in subsection (b)—

10 (A) in paragraph (1)(A), in the first sen-
 11 tence, by striking “2026” and inserting
 12 “2031”; and

13 (B) in paragraph (2)(A), in the first sen-
 14 tence, by striking “2026” and inserting
 15 “2031”.

16 (b) MULTISTATE CONSERVATION GRANT PRO-
 17 GRAM.—Section 14(e) of the Dingell-Johnson Sport Fish
 18 Restoration Act (16 U.S.C. 777m(e)) is amended—

19 (1) in the matter preceding paragraph (1), by
 20 striking “Not more than \$1,200,000 of each” and
 21 inserting “Each”; and

22 (2) in paragraph (1), in the matter preceding
 23 subparagraph (A), by striking “\$200,000” and in-
 24 serting “The greater of 0.0375 percent of such ap-
 25 propriation or \$200,000”.
