A BILL

To extend section 702 of the Foreign Intelligence
Surveillance Act of 1978 for 18 months.

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF SECTION 702 AUTHORITY FOR**
4 **18 MONTHS.**

5 (a) EFFECTIVE DATES.—Section 403(b) of the FISA
6 Amendments Act of 2008 (Public Law 110–261; 122 Stat.
7 2474) is amended—

8 (1) in paragraph (1) (50 U.S.C. 1881 note), by
9 striking “two years after the date of enactment of

1 the Reforming Intelligence and Securing America
2 Act” and inserting “on October 20, 2027”; and

3 (2) in paragraph (2) (18 U.S.C. 2511 note), in
4 the matter preceding subparagraph (A), by striking
5 “two years after the date of enactment of the Re-
6 forming Intelligence and Securing America Act” and
7 inserting “on October 20, 2027”.

8 (b) CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—Section 404(b)(1)
9 of the FISA Amendments Act of 2008 (Public Law 110–
10 261; 122 Stat. 2476), is amended, in the heading, by
11 striking “TWO YEARS AFTER THE DATE OF ENACTMENT
12 OF THE REFORMING INTELLIGENCE AND SECURING AMER-
13 ICA ACT” and inserting “OCTOBER 20, 2027”;

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
