3 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF SECTION 702 AUTHORITY FOR 3**

4 **YEARS.**

5 (a) EFFECTIVE DATES.—Section 403(b) of the FISA
6 Amendments Act of 2008 (Public Law 110–261; 122 Stat.
7 2474) is amended—

1 (1) in paragraph (1) (50 U.S.C. 1881 note), by
2 striking “two years after the date of enactment of
3 the Reforming Intelligence and Securing America
4 Act” and inserting “April 20, 2029”; and

5 (2) in paragraph (2) (18 U.S.C. 2511 note), in
6 the matter preceding subparagraph (A), by striking
7 “two years after the date of enactment of the Re-
8 forming Intelligence and Securing America Act” and
9 inserting “April 20, 2029”.

10 (b) CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—Section 404(b)(1)
11 of the FISA Amendments Act of 2008 (Public Law 110–
12 261; 122 Stat. 2476), is amended, in the heading, by
13 striking “two years after the date of enactment of the Re-
14 forming Intelligence and Securing America Act” and in-
15 serting “April 20, 2029”.
