Mr. GRAHAM (for himself, Mrs. BRITT, and Mr. SCHMITT) introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Finance

A BILL

To authorize the East Wing Modernization Project, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “White House Safety
5 and Security Act of 2026”.

6 **SEC. 2. AUTHORIZATION OF EAST WING MODERNIZATION**
7 **PROJECT.**

8 (a) APPROPRIATION.—In addition to amounts other-
9 wise available, including monetary or in-kind donations in
10 the White House Repair and Restoration account as of
11 the date of enactment of this Act, there is appropriated

1 to the President for fiscal year 2026, out of any money
 2 in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated,
 3 \$400,000,000, to remain available until January 20,
 4 2029, for design, construction, and other appropriate ex-
 5 penses to complete the East Wing Modernization Project,
 6 including a secure State Ballroom and visitor screening
 7 facility and any other related national security facility,
 8 pursuant to section 105(d) of title 3, United States Code.

9 (b) EXTENSION OF CUSTOMS USER FEES.—

10 (1) IN GENERAL.—Section 13031(j)(3) of the
 11 Consolidated Omnibus Budget Reconciliation Act of
 12 1985 (19 U.S.C. 58c(j)(3)) is amended—

13 (A) in subparagraph (A), by striking “De-
 14 cember 31, 2031” and inserting “March 31,
 15 2032”; and

16 (B) in subparagraph (B)(i), by striking
 17 “December 31, 2031” and inserting “March
 18 31, 2032”.

19 (2) RATE FOR MERCHANDISE PROCESSING
 20 FEES.—Section 503 of the United States-Korea
 21 Free Trade Agreement Implementation Act (Public
 22 Law 112–41; 19 U.S.C. 3805 note) is amended by
 23 striking “December 31, 2031” and inserting “March
 24 31, 2032”.
