Mr. SCOTT of Florida (for himself, Mr. TUBERVILLE, Mrs. BLACKBURN, Mr. ROUNDS, Mr. LEE, Mr. BUDD, and Mr. LANKFORD) introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

To prohibit the sharing of certain information about Federal law enforcement officers, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Blocking Leaks Under-
5 mining Enforcement Act” or the “BLUE Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON SHARING OF CERTAIN INFORMA-**
7 **TION.**

8 Section 119 of title 18, United States Code, is
9 amended—

1 (1) in subsection (a)—

2 (A) in paragraph (1), by striking “or” at
3 the end;

4 (B) in paragraph (2), by striking the
5 comma at the end and inserting “; or”; and

6 (C) by inserting after paragraph (2) the
7 following:

8 “(3) in the case of a covered person who is a
9 Federal law enforcement officer, with the intent to
10 physically obstruct, impede, interfere with, or retali-
11 ate against, or to aid another in physically obstruct-
12 ing, impeding, interfering with, or retaliating
13 against, any lawful duty, investigation, operation, or
14 official proceeding of the United States involving
15 such officer,”; and

16 (2) in subsection (b)—

17 (A) in paragraph (1), by inserting “, and,
18 with respect to a Federal law enforcement offi-
19 cer, any physical location at which such officer
20 is or is reasonably expected to be present
21 (whether on or off duty)” after “that indi-
22 vidual”; and

23 (B) by amending paragraph (4) to read as
24 follows:

1 “(4) the terms ‘Federal law enforcement officer’
2 and ‘immediate family’ have the meanings given the
3 terms in section 115.”.

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
