5 (a) CIVIL SERVICE RETIREMENT SYSTEM.—Section
6 8335(c) of title 5, United States Code, is amended by
7 striking “becomes 60 years of age” and inserting “attains
8 an age determined by the Board, which shall be not less
9 than 57 years of age and not more than 62 years of age”.

1 (b) FEDERAL EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM.—
2 Section 8425(c) of title 5, United States Code, is amended
3 by striking “becomes 60 years of age” and inserting “at-
4 tains an age determined by the Board, which shall be not
5 less than 57 years of age and not more than 62 years
6 of age”.
