A BILL

To amend title 10, United States Code, to include the Coast Guard in the requirement to buy certain articles from American sources.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Coast Guard Personnel
5 Equipment Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. REQUIREMENT FOR COAST GUARD TO BUY CER-**
7 **TAIN ARTICLES FROM AMERICAN SOURCES.**

8 Section 4862 of title 10, United States Code, is
9 amended—

1 (1) in subsection (a), by striking “Department
2 of Defense” and inserting “Department of Defense
3 or any branch of the Armed Forces”;

4 (2) in subsection (c), by striking “the Secretary
5 of the military department concerned” and inserting
6 “the Secretary concerned”;

7 (3) in subsection (g)—

8 (A) in paragraph (1), by striking “Depart-
9 ment of Defense” and inserting “Department of
10 Defense or any branch of the Armed Forces”;
11 and

12 (B) in paragraph (2)(B), by striking “The
13 Secretary of Defense” and inserting “The Sec-
14 retary of Defense or, with respect to the Coast
15 Guard when it is not operating as a service in
16 the Navy, the Secretary of Homeland Security”;

17 (4) in subsection (h)—

18 (A) in paragraph (2)(B), by striking “Sec-
19 retary of Defense” and inserting “Secretary of
20 Defense or, with respect to the Coast Guard
21 when it is not operating as a service in the
22 Navy, the Secretary of Homeland Security”;
23 and

24 (B) in paragraph (3), by striking “Sec-
25 retary of Defense” and inserting “Secretary of

1 Defense, in consultation with the Secretary of
2 Homeland Security,”; and
3 (5) in subsection (k), by striking “or of the
4 military department concerned” and inserting “or
5 the Secretary concerned”.

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
