A BILL

To amend the Safe Drinking Water Act to authorize grant funds under the Midsize and Large Drinking Water System Infrastructure Resilience and Sustainability Program to be used to increase resilience to extreme temperatures, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Protecting America’s
5 Drinking Water from Extreme Temperatures Act of
6 2026”.

1 **SEC. 2. MIDSIZE AND LARGE DRINKING WATER SYSTEM IN-**
2 **FRASTRUCTURE RESILIENCE AND SUSTAIN-**
3 **ABILITY PROGRAM.**

4 Section 1459F of the Safe Drinking Water Act (42
5 U.S.C. 300j–19g) is amended—

6 (1) in each of subsections (b) and (c), by strik-
7 ing “natural hazards and extreme weather events”
8 each place it appears and inserting “natural haz-
9 ards, extreme weather events, and extreme tempera-
10 tures”;

11 (2) in subsection (c)(2), by striking “natural
12 hazards or extreme weather events, including risks
13 to drinking water from flooding” and inserting “nat-
14 ural hazards, extreme weather events (including
15 risks to drinking water from flooding), or extreme
16 temperatures”;

17 (3) in subsection (d)—

18 (A) in paragraph (2), by inserting “ex-
19 treme temperatures,” after “weather events,”;

20 (B) in paragraph (3), by inserting “or ex-
21 treme temperatures” after “weather events”;

22 (C) in each of paragraphs (4) and (5), by
23 striking “or extreme weather events” each place
24 it appears and inserting “extreme weather
25 events, or extreme temperatures”; and

1 (D) in paragraph (6)(A), by striking “haz-
2 ards or extreme weather events” and inserting
3 “hazards, extreme weather events, or extreme
4 temperatures”; and
5 (4) in subsection (f)(1), by striking “2022
6 through 2026” and inserting “2027 through 2032”.

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
