A BILL

To amend title II of the Social Security Act to increase the age threshold for eligibility for child's insurance benefits on the basis of disability.

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Fairness for Disabled
5 Young Adults Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. INCREASE TO AGE THRESHOLD FOR CHILD’S IN-**
 2 **SURANCE BENEFITS ON THE BASIS OF DIS-**
 3 **ABILITY.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 202(d) of the Social Secu-
 5 rity Act (42 U.S.C. 402(d)) is amended by striking “age
 6 of 22” each place it appears and inserting “age of 26”.

7 (b) CONFORMING AMENDMENTS.—

8 (1) Section 205(j)(2)(C)(vi)(II)(cc) of the Social
 9 Security Act (42 U.S.C. 405(j)(2)(C)(vi)(II)(cc)) is
 10 amended by striking “age of 22” and inserting “age
 11 of 26”.

12 (2) Section 225(a) of the Social Security Act
 13 (42 U.S.C. 425(a)) is amended by striking “age of
 14 22” and inserting “age of 26”.

15 (3) Section 1631(a)(2)(B)(xvii)(II)(cc) of the
 16 Social Security Act (42 U.S.C.
 17 1383(a)(2)(B)(xvii)(II)(cc)) is amended by striking
 18 “age of 22” and inserting “age of 26”.

19 (4) Section 1634(c) of the Social Security Act
 20 (42 U.S.C. 1383c(c)) is amended by striking “age of
 21 22” and inserting “age of 26”.

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
