A BILL

To require the Postal Service to implement recommendations from the Inspector General of the United States Postal Service for improving identification and notification of undelivered and partially delivered routes, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Postal Delivery Ac-
5 countability Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. POSTAL SERVICE REQUIRED TO IMPLEMENT CER-**
2 **TAIN RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE INSPEC-**
3 **TOR GENERAL.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Postal Service shall review
5 and, to the extent practicable, implement the rec-
6 ommendations of the Inspector General of the United
7 States Postal Service with respect to undelivered and par-
8 tially delivered routes contained in the report set forth by
9 the Inspector General entitled “Delivery Operations—Un-
10 delivered and Partially Delivered Routes” (Report Num-
11 ber 21–262–R23) and dated December 16, 2022.

12 (b) DEADLINE.—The Postal Service shall implement
13 the recommendations described in subsection (a) not later
14 than 1 year after the date of enactment of this Act.

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
