Ms. ROSEN introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

To prohibit Federal funds from being used for certain legal financial settlements, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Redirecting Trump
5 Slush Funds to Lower Health Care Costs Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON FEDERAL FUNDS BEING USED**
7 **FOR CERTAIN LEGAL FINANCIAL SETTLE-**
8 **MENTS.**

9 (a) IN GENERAL.—No Federal funds, including
10 amounts appropriated under section 1304 of title 31,

1 United States Code (commonly known as the “Judgment
2 Fund”), may be used by any Federal agency—

3 (1) for any legal financial settlement to the
4 President or for the personal or political benefit of
5 the President; or

6 (2) to establish or maintain any commission,
7 fund (including the “Anti-Weaponization Fund” an-
8 nounced by the Attorney General on May 18, 2026),
9 or mechanism utilized to provide the compensation
10 described in paragraph (1).

11 (b) APPROPRIATION.—Out of any money in the
12 Treasury not otherwise appropriated, there is appro-
13 priated to the Secretary of Health and Human Services
14 \$1,776,000,000, to address health care costs through
15 funding for the Medicaid program under title XIX of the
16 Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1396 et seq.), including
17 funding to eliminate the funding and eligibility cuts en-
18 acted in Public Law 119–21 (commonly known as the
19 “One Big Beautiful Bill Act”).
