Ms. ROSEN introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

To prohibit Federal funds from being used for certain legal financial settlements, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Redirecting Trump
5 Slush Funds to Support Law Enforcement Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON FEDERAL FUNDS BEING USED**
7 **FOR CERTAIN LEGAL FINANCIAL SETTLE-**
8 **MENTS.**

9 (a) IN GENERAL.—No Federal funds, including
10 amounts appropriated under section 1304 of title 31,

1 United States Code (commonly known as the “Judgment
2 Fund”), may be used by any Federal agency—

3 (1) for any legal financial settlement to the
4 President or for the personal or political benefit of
5 the President; or

6 (2) to establish or maintain any commission,
7 fund (including the “Anti-Weaponization Fund” an-
8 nounced by the Attorney General on May 18, 2026),
9 successor fund, or other mechanism utilized to pro-
10 vide the compensation described in paragraph (1).

11 (b) APPROPRIATION.—Out of any money in the
12 Treasury not otherwise appropriated, there is appro-
13 priated to the Attorney General \$1,776,000,000, to carry
14 out the Public Safety Officers’ Death Benefits Program
15 under part L of title I of the Omnibus Crime Control and
16 Safe Streets Act of 1968 (34 U.S.C. 10281 et seq.) and
17 the COPS Hiring Program under part Q of title I of the
18 Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968 (34
19 U.S.C. 10381 et seq.).

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
