1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Unlocking Next-Gen-
3 eration Licensing and Opportunities for Collaborative
4 Know-how for AUKUS Act” or the “UNLOCK AUKUS
5 Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. MODIFICATION OF LIMITATION RELATING TO EX-**
7 **PORTS AND TRANSFERS OF DEFENSE ARTI-**
8 **CLES AND SERVICES UNDER THE AUKUS**
9 **PARTNERSHIP.**
