A BILL

To amend title 18, United States Code, to provide that officers and employees of the executive branch are required to recuse themselves in matters affecting the financial interests of their previous employers, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Stop Millionaires
5 Using Service for Kickbacks Act” or the “Stop MUSK
6 Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. RECUSAL OF EXECUTIVE BRANCH OFFICERS AND**
2 **EMPLOYEES IN MATTERS AFFECTING FINAN-**
3 **CIAL INTERESTS OF PREVIOUS EMPLOYERS.**

4 Section 208(a) of title 18, United States Code, is
5 amended by inserting after “organization in which he is
6 serving as officer, director, trustee, general partner or em-
7 ployee,” the following: “organization for which he, during
8 the 4-year period preceding such participation, served as
9 an officer, director, trustee, general partner, agent, attor-
10 ney, consultant, contractor, employee, or direct compet-
11 itor, organization (other than a political organization de-
12 scribed in section 527(e) of the Internal Revenue Code of
13 1986) in which he is an active participant,”.

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
