A BILL

To amend the Food, Agriculture, Conservation, and Trade Act of 1990 to include spotted lanternfly control research and development as a high-priority research and extension initiative, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Spotted Lanternfly Re-
5 search and Development Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. INCLUDING SPOTTED LANTERNFLY CONTROL RE-**
 2 **SEARCH AND DEVELOPMENT AS A HIGH-PRI-**
 3 **ORITY RESEARCH AND EXTENSION INITIA-**
 4 **TIVE.**

5 Section 1672(d) of the Food, Agriculture, Conserva-
 6 tion, and Trade Act of 1990 (7 U.S.C. 5925(d)) is amend-
 7 ed by adding at the end the following:

8 “(21) SPOTTED LANTERNFLY CONTROL.—Re-
 9 search and extension grants may be made under this
 10 section for the purposes of developing and dissemi-
 11 nating research-based tools and treatments to com-
 12 bat the Spotted Lanternfly (*Lycorma delicatula*).”.

13 **SEC. 3. REAUTHORIZATION OF HIGH-PRIORITY RESEARCH**
 14 **AND EXTENSION INITIATIVES.**

15 Section 1672 of the Food, Agriculture, Conservation,
 16 and Trade Act of 1990 (7 U.S.C. 5925) is amended by
 17 striking “2023” each place it appears and inserting
 18 “2028”.

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
