Mr. RISCH (for himself and Mr. CRAPO) introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Energy and Natural Resources

A BILL

To facilitate the conveyance of certain land in Bonners Ferry, Idaho, platted under section 2387 of the Revised Statutes, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. FACILITATION OF CONVEYANCE OF CERTAIN**
4 **LAND IN BONNERS FERRY, IDAHO.**

5 (a) DISCLAIMER OF INTEREST.—To facilitate the
6 conveyance of the covered land described in subsection (b)
7 that was platted under section 2387 of the Revised Stat-
8 utes (43 U.S.C. 718) (repealed by section 703(a) of the
9 Federal Land Policy and Management Act of 1976 (Public

1 Law 94–579; 90 Stat. 2790)), not later than 90 days after
2 the date of enactment of this Act, the Secretary of the
3 Interior shall issue a recordable disclaimer of interest of
4 the United States in and to the covered land.

5 (b) DESCRIPTION OF COVERED LAND.—The covered
6 land referred to in subsection (a) is the approximately
7 15.12 acres of land in Bonners Ferry, Idaho, depicted as
8 “Eaton” on the map entitled “Eaton” and dated Decem-
9 ber 22, 1893, excluding the portion of the land within the
10 boundary of the Kootenai Indian Reservation.

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
