Mr. CRAMER (for himself, Mr. KING, and Mr. SULLIVAN) introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Veterans' Affairs

A BILL

To extend and modify the transportation grant program of the Department of Veterans Affairs, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Supporting Rural Vet-
5 erans Access to Healthcare Services Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. EXTENSION AND MODIFICATION OF TRANSPOR-**
2 **TATION GRANT PROGRAM OF DEPARTMENT**
3 **OF VETERANS AFFAIRS.**

4 Section 307 of the Caregivers and Veterans Omnibus
5 Health Services Act of 2010 (Public Law 111–163; 38
6 U.S.C. 1710 note) is amended—

7 (1) in subsection (a)—

8 (A) in paragraph (2), by adding at the end
9 the following new subparagraphs:

10 “(C) Tribal organizations.

11 “(D) Native Hawaiian organizations.”;

12 (B) in paragraph (3), by striking “State
13 veterans service agency or veterans service or-
14 ganization awarded” and inserting “recipient
15 of”; and

16 (C) by amending paragraph (4) to read as
17 follows:

18 “(4) MAXIMUM AMOUNT.—

19 “(A) IN GENERAL.—Except as provided in
20 subparagraph (B), the amount of a grant under
21 this section may not exceed \$50,000.

22 “(B) ADDITIONAL AMOUNT.—In the case
23 of a county that has more than five commu-
24 nities that are off the road system, the amount
25 of a grant awarded with respect to that county
26 under this section may be increased by an

1 amount not to exceed 50 percent of the amount
 2 specified in subparagraph (A).”;

3 (2) in subsection (c)—

4 (A) by redesignating paragraph (2) as
 5 paragraph (4); and

6 (B) by inserting after paragraph (1) the
 7 following new paragraphs:

8 “(2) NATIVE HAWAIIAN ORGANIZATION.—The
 9 term ‘Native Hawaiian organization’ has the mean-
 10 ing given that term in section 6207 of the Elemen-
 11 tary and Secondary Education Act of 1965 (20
 12 U.S.C. 7517).

13 “(3) TRIBAL ORGANIZATION.—The term ‘Tribal
 14 organization’ has the meaning given that term in
 15 section 4 of the Indian Self-Determination and Edu-
 16 cation Assistance Act (25 U.S.C. 5304).”; and

17 (3) in subsection (d), by striking “\$3,000,000
 18 for each of fiscal years 2010 through 2022” and in-
 19 serting “such sums as may be necessary for each of
 20 fiscal years 2025 through 2029”.

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
