Mr. SCOTT of Florida introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Finance

A BILL

To prohibit importation of commercially produced fresh citrus fruit originating from the People’s Republic of China.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “United States Citrus
5 Protection Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON IMPORTATION OF COMMER-**
2 **CIALLY PRODUCED FRESH CITRUS FRUIT**
3 **ORIGINATING FROM THE PEOPLE’S REPUB-**
4 **LIC OF CHINA.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding any other provi-
6 sion of law, articles of commercially produced fresh citrus
7 fruit originating from the People’s Republic of China may
8 not be imported into the United States.

9 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—This Act shall take effect on
10 the date that is 90 days after the date of the enactment
11 of this Act.

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
