3 **SECTION 1. USE OF EMANCIPATION HALL FOR CEREMONY**
4 **TO PRESENT THE CONGRESSIONAL GOLD**
5 **MEDAL TO THE UNITED STATES ARMY RANG-**
6 **ERS VETERANS OF WORLD WAR II.**

7 (a) AUTHORIZATION.—Emancipation Hall in the
8 Capitol Visitor Center is authorized to be used on June

1 26, 2025, for a ceremony to present the Congressional
2 Gold Medal awarded under the United States Army Rang-
3 ers Veterans of World War II Act (Public Law 117–132;
4 31 U.S.C. 5111 note).

5 (b) PREPARATIONS.—Physical preparations for the
6 conduct of the ceremony described in subsection (a) shall
7 be carried out in accordance with such conditions as may
8 be prescribed by the Architect of the Capitol.
