JOINT RESOLUTION

Providing for congressional disapproval of the proposed foreign military sale to the Government of Israel of certain defense articles and services.

1 *Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives*
2 *of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That the following proposed foreign military sale to the
4 Government of Israel is prohibited:

5 (1) The sale of the following defense articles
6 and services described in Transmittal No. 26–00,
7 submitted to Congress pursuant to section
8 36(b)(5)(C) of the Arms Export Control Act (22
9 U.S.C. 2776(b)(5)(C)) and published in the Con-

1 gressional Record on March 12, 2026: The inclusion
2 of the following MDE items: ten thousand (10,000)
3 BLU-111 500-pound general purpose bombs. The
4 following non-MDE items will also be included: other
5 related elements of logistics and program support.
