JOINT RESOLUTION

Providing for congressional disapproval of the proposed foreign military sale to the Government of Israel of certain defense articles and services.

1 *Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives*
2 *of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That the following proposed foreign military sale to the
4 Government of Israel is prohibited:

5 (1) The sale of the following defense articles
6 and services described in Transmittal No. 26–32,
7 submitted to Congress pursuant to section 36(b)(1)
8 of the Arms Export Control Act (22 U.S.C.
9 2776(b)(1)) and published in the Congressional

1 Record on March 12, 2026: Major Defense Equip-
2 ment (MDE): Twelve thousand (12,000) BLU-
3 110A/B general purpose, 1,000-pound bomb bodies.
4 Non-MDE: The following non-MDE items will also
5 be included: U.S. Government and contractor engi-
6 neering, logistics, and technical support services; and
7 other related elements of logistics and program sup-
8 port.
