JOINT RESOLUTION

Providing for congressional disapproval of the proposed foreign military sales to the Government of the United Arab Emirates of certain defense articles and services.

1 *Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives*
2 *of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That the following proposed foreign military sale to the
4 Government of the United Arab Emirates is prohibited:
5 (1) The sale of the following defense articles
6 and services, described in Transmittal No. RSAT
7 26–46, submitted to Congress pursuant to section
8 36(b)(1) of the Arms Export Control Act (22 U.S.C.
9 2776(b)(1)), and published in the Congressional

13 navigation; Joint Mission Planning System with
14 unique planning components and software; aircraft
15 maintenance support equipment; spare and repair
16 parts, consumables and accessories, and repair and
17 return support; weapons and weapons support equip-
18 ment; test equipment; training aids, devices, and
19 spare parts; classified and unclassified software and
20 software support; classified and unclassified publica-
21 tions and technical documentation; personnel train-
22 ing and training equipment; transportation support;
23 aerial refueling; U.S. Government and contractor en-
24 gineering, technical, and logistics support services;

- 1 and other related elements of logistics and program
- 2 support.
