Mr. MARKEY (for himself, Mr. SANDERS, and Mr. MERKLEY) introduced the following joint resolution; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Foreign Relations

JOINT RESOLUTION

Providing for congressional disapproval of the proposed foreign military sale to the Government of Saudi Arabia of certain defense articles and services.

1 *Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives*
2 *of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That the following proposed foreign military sale to the
4 Government of Saudi Arabia is prohibited:

5 (1) The sale of the following defense articles
6 and services described in Transmittal No. 26–35,
7 which was submitted to Congress pursuant to sec-
8 tion 36(b)(1) of the Arms Export Control Act (22
9 U.S.C. 2776(b)(1)) and communication of which was

1 published in the Congressional Record on September
2 15, 2026 (Executive Communication 4683): five
3 thousand four (5,004) KMU-572 Joint Direct At-
4 tack Munition (JDAM) guidance kits; five thousand
5 (5,000) KMU-556 JDAM guidance kits; five thou-
6 sand four (5,004) BLU-111 500-lb general purpose
7 bombs; and five thousand (5,000) BLU-117 2,000-
8 lb general purpose bombs. The following non-major
9 defense equipment will also be included: FMU-139
10 fuze systems; DSU-38 and DSU-40 target detec-
11 tors; containers and support equipment; spare parts,
12 consumables and accessories, and repair and return
13 support; U.S. Government and contractor engineer-
14 ing, technical, and logistics support services; and
15 other related elements of logistics and program sup-
16 port.

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
