Mr. SANDERS introduced the following joint resolution; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Foreign Relations

JOINT RESOLUTION

Providing for congressional disapproval of the proposed foreign military sale to Israel of certain defense articles and services.

1 *Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives*
2 *of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That the following proposed foreign military sale to Israel
4 is prohibited:

5 (1) The sale of the following defense articles
6 and services, described in Transmittal No. 24–104,
7 submitted to Congress pursuant to section 36(b)(1)
8 of the Arms Export Control Act (22 U.S.C.
9 2776(b)(1)), and published in the Congressional
10 Record on February 10, 2025: three thousand

1 (3,000) AGM-114 Hellfire Air-to-Ground Missiles,
2 to include one or any combination of the R3, F, F/
3 A, K1, K1A, K2, K3, K3A, KA, N, N3, and/or R
4 variants. The following non-MDE items will also be
5 included: support and test equipment; integration
6 and test support; spare and repair parts; software
7 delivery and support; publications and technical doc-
8 umentation; personnel training and training equip-
9 ment; U.S. Government and contractor engineering;
10 technical and logistics support services; storage; and
11 other related elements of logistics and program sup-
12 port.

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
