Mr. SANDERS introduced the following joint resolution; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Foreign Relations

JOINT RESOLUTION

Providing for congressional disapproval of the proposed foreign military sale to the Government of Israel of certain defense articles and services.

1 *Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives*
2 *of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That the following proposed foreign military sale to the
4 Government of Israel is prohibited:

5 (1) The sale of the following defense articles
6 and services described in Transmittal No. 25–26,
7 submitted to Congress pursuant to section 36(b)(1)
8 of the Arms Export Control Act (22 U.S.C.
9 2776(b)(1)), and published in the Congressional
10 Record on March 3, 2025: The following Major De-

1 fense Equipment (MDE): Two hundred one (201)
2 MK 83 MOD 4/MOD 5 General Purpose 1,000-
3 pound bomb bodies. Four thousand seven hundred
4 ninety-nine (4,799) BLU-110A/B General Purpose
5 1,000-pound bomb bodies. One thousand five hun-
6 dred (1,500) KMU-559C/B Joint Direct Attack Mu-
7 nition (JDAM) guidance kits for the MK 83 bomb
8 body. Three thousand five hundred (3,500) KMU-
9 559J/B JDAM guidance kits for the MK 83 bomb
10 body. The following non-MDE items will also be in-
11 cluded: U.S. Government and contractor engineer-
12 ing, logistics, and technical support services; and
13 other related elements of logistics and program sup-
14 port.

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
