JOINT RESOLUTION

Providing for congressional disapproval of the report of enhancement or upgrade of sensitive foreign military related to a sale to the Government of Israel of certain defense articles and services.

1 *Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives*
2 *of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That the following proposed foreign military sale to the
4 Government of Israel is prohibited:

5 (1) The sale of the following defense articles
6 and services described in Transmittal No. 25–0C,
7 submitted to Congress pursuant to section
8 36(b)(5)(C) of the Arms Export Control Act (22

1 U.S.C. 2776(b)(5)(C)), and published in the Con-
2 gressional Record on March 3, 2025: An increase in
3 Major Defense Equipment (MDE) value by
4 \$624,000,000 and non-MDE value by \$269,000,000,
5 due to recent cost increases.

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
