## JOINT RESOLUTION

Providing for congressional disapproval of the proposed foreign military sale to the Government of the United Arab Emirates of certain defense articles and services.

1       *Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives*  
2       *of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*  
3       That the following proposed foreign military sale to the  
4       Government of the United Arab Emirates is prohibited:  
5               (1) The sale of the following defense articles  
6               and services described in Transmittal No. 24–00Q,  
7               submitted to Congress pursuant to section  
8               36(b)(5)(C) of the Arms Export Control Act (22  
9               U.S.C. 2776(b)(5)(C)), and published in the Con-

1       gressional Record on May 13, 2025: An extension of  
2       the previously notified Foreign Military Sales Order  
3       (FMSO) II for blanket order requisitions under a  
4       Cooperative Logistics Supply Support Agreement  
5       (CLSSA) for common spares/repair parts to support  
6       the United Arab Emirates’ fleet of AH–64 Apache,  
7       UH–60 Black Hawk, and CH–47 Chinook aircraft,  
8       additional support, and other related elements of lo-  
9       gistics and program support.
