Honoring the 2026 Olympians and Paralympians from
Oregon.

Whereas the United States Olympic and Paralympic Committee recognized Oregonians that competed in Milano Cortina;

Whereas Jacqueline Wiles competed in alpine skiing;

Whereas Hunter Hess competed in freestyle skiing;

Whereas Sean FitzSimons competed in snowboarding;

Whereas Alessandro Barbieri competed in snowboarding;

Whereas Anna Soens competed in para alpine skiing; and

Whereas Ravi Drugan competed in para alpine skiing: Now,
therefore, be it

1 *Resolved*, That the Senate—

2 (1) congratulates the Oregonians who competed
3 in the 2026 Milano Cortina Olympics and
4 Paralympics;

5 (2) recognizes the invaluable contributions of
6 the families, coaches, and staff who supported these
7 athletes at the 2026 Milano Cortina Games; and

8 (3) honors the efforts of all the Oregonian
9 Olympians and Paralympians and their accomplish-
10 ments at the 2026 Milano Cortina Games.

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
