Mr. OSSOFF (for himself and Mr. WARNOCK) submitted the following
resolution; which was considered and agreed to

RESOLUTION

Commemorating the first anniversary of the mass shooting
at Fort Stewart, Georgia, on August 6, 2025.

Whereas, on August 6, 2025, 5 soldiers at Fort Stewart,
Georgia, were shot and wounded by a fellow soldier;

Whereas all 5 victims survived the attack;

Whereas unarmed soldiers responded immediately to subdue
the shooter and to render first aid to the victims, saving
lives and preventing further tragedy;

Whereas the unarmed soldiers acted selflessly, putting their
own lives at risk; and

Whereas the Fort Stewart community has remained valiant
and supportive since the incident: Now, therefore, be it

1 *Resolved*, That the Senate—

1 (1) recognizes and honors the victims of the
2 shooting;

3 (2) commends the actions of the Fort Stewart
4 soldiers that responded to subdue the shooter;

5 (3) commends the bravery of the first respond-
6 ers;

7 (4) acknowledges those that continue to support
8 the Fort Stewart community in the wake of the
9 shooting, including religious leaders and mental
10 health care providers; and

11 (5) expresses support for the victims, their fam-
12 ilies, and the Fort Stewart community.

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
