Res. 4.—Providing for congressional disapproval of the rule submitted by the Department of Agriculture under chapter 8 of title 5, United States Code, relating to risk zones for introduction of bovine spongiform encephalopathy. Referred to Agriculture, Nutrition, and Forestry Feb. 14, 2005. Committee discharged. Ordered placed on the calendar Mar. 2, 2005. Passed Senate Mar. 3, 2005; Roll No. 19: 52-46. Received in House and held at desk Mar. 7, 2005.			
S.J. Res. 12 (H.J. Res. 10).—Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the United States authorizing Congress to prohibit the physical desecration of the flag of the United States. Referred to the Judiciary Apr. 14, 2005. Reported amended June 20, 2006; no written report. Considered June 26, 2006. Failed of passage (two-thirds required) June 27, 2006; Roll No. 189: 66-34.			
S.J. Res. 15.—To acknowledge a long history of official depredations and ill-conceived policies by the United States Government regarding Indian tribes and offer an apology to all Native Peoples on behalf of the United States. Referred to Indian Affairs Apr. 19, 2005. Reported July 28, 2005; Rept. 109-113.			
S.J. Res. 18 (H.J. Res. 52).—Approving the renewal of import restrictions contained in the Burmese Freedom and Democracy Act of 2003. Referred to Finance May 10, 2005. Reported July 12, 2005; Rept. 109-101. Considered July 19, 2005. Returned to the calendar July 19, 2005. See H.J. Res. 52 for further action.			
S.J. Res. 19.—Calling upon the President to issue a proclamation recognizing the 30th anniversary of the Helsinki Final Act. Referred to Foreign Relations May 17, 2005. Committee discharged. Passed Senate July 27, 2005. Passed Senate July 27, 2005. Received in House and referred to International Relations July 28, 2005. Rules suspended. Passed House with amendment Sept. 6, 2005; Roll No. 455: 393-1.			
S.J. Res. 20.—Disapproving a rule promulgated by the Administrator of the Environmental Protection Agency to delist coal and oil-direct utility units from the source category list under the Clean Air Act. Referred to Environment and Public Works June 29, 2005. Committee discharged. Ordered placed on the calendar July 18, 2005. Failed of passage Sept. 13, 2005; Roll No. 225: 47-51.			
S.J. Res. 28 (H.J. Res. 78).—Approving the location of the commemorative work in the District of Columbia honoring former President Dwight D. Eisenhower. Referred to Energy and Natural Resources Feb. 7, 2006. Reported Apr. 3, 2006; Rept. 109-227. Passed Senate Apr. 4, 2006. Received in House and held at desk Apr. 4, 2006. Rules suspended.
