UNANIMOUS CONSENT AGREEMENTS

H.R. 6049 (ORDER NO. 767)

1.—*Ordered*, That upon the conclusion of Morning Business on Monday, June 16, 2008, the Senate resume consideration of the motion to proceed to H.R. 6049, an Act to amend the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to provide incentives for energy production and conservation, to extend certain expiring provisions, to provide individual income tax relief, and for other purposes; provided, that the time until 5:30 p.m. be equally divided and controlled between the Leaders or their designees, with the final 20 minutes divided between the Majority and Republican Leaders, with the Majority Leader controlling the final 10 minutes; provided further, that the cloture vote on the motion to proceed to H.R. 6049 occur at 5:30 p.m. on Monday, June 16, 2008.

Ordered further, That the mandatory quorum required under Rule XXII be waived. (June 12, 2008.)

S. 1974

2.—*Ordered*, That S. 1974, a bill to make technical corrections related to the Pension Protection Act of 2006, remain at the desk. (Mar. 31, 2008.)

VETO MESSAGE ON S. 5

3.—*Ordered*, That the veto message on S. 5, the Stem Cell Research Enhancement Act of 2007, be considered as read and that it be printed in the Record and spread in full upon the Journal.

Ordered further, That the message be held at the desk. (June 20, 2007.)

H.R. 3997

4.—*Ordered*, That if the Senate receives from the House a message on H.R. 3997, an act to amend the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to provide earnings assistance and tax relief to members of the uniformed services, volunteer firefighters, and Peace Corps volunteers, and for other purposes, with an amendment that is not germane to the Senate amendment or the underlying bill, that the bill and its amendments be referred to the Committee on Finance.
