## HOUSE MESSAGE TO ACCOMPANY H.R. 3221

1.—*Ordered*, That at 9:30 a.m. on Wednesday, June 25, 2008, the Senate resume consideration of the Message from the House of Representatives to accompany H.R. 3221, an act to provide needed housing reform and for other purposes; provided, that no further motions to refer be in order during the pendency of the House message.

*Ordered further*, That all time during the adjournment of the Senate count against the post-cloture time under Rule XXII.

*Ordered further*, That the filing deadline for amendments to the motion to concur with Amdt. No. 4983 be 10:30 a.m. on Tuesday, June 24, 2008. (*June 19, 20, 24, 2008.*)

## H.R. 6304 (ORDER NO. 827)

2.—*Ordered*, That with respect to the cloture vote on the motion to proceed to H.R. 6304, an act to amend the Foreign Intelligence Surveillance Act of 1978 to establish a procedure for authorizing certain acquisitions of foreign intelligence, and for other purposes, the mandatory quorum required under Rule XXII be waived. (*June 24, 2008.*)

## S. 1974

3.—*Ordered*, That S. 1974, a bill to make technical corrections related to the Pension Protection Act of 2006, remain at the desk. (*Mar. 31, 2008.*)

## VETO MESSAGE ON S. 5

4.—*Ordered*, That the veto message on S. 5, the Stem Cell Research Enhancement Act of 2007, be considered as read and that it be printed in the Record and spread in full upon the Journal.

*Ordered further*, That the message be held at the desk. (*June 20, 2007.*)

## H.R. 3997

5.—*Ordered*, That if the Senate receives from the House a message on H.R. 3997, an act to amend the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to provide earnings assistance and tax relief to members of the uniformed services, volunteer firefighters, and Peace Corps volunteers, and for other purposes, with an amendment that is not germane to the Senate amendment or the underlying bill, that the bill and its amendments be referred to the Committee on Finance. (*Dec. 12, 19, 2007.*)
