**UNANIMOUS CONSENT AGREEMENT**

H.R. 1256 (ORDER NO. 47)

*Ordered*, That upon the conclusion of Morning Business on Monday, June 8, 2009, the Senate resume consideration of H.R. 1256, an act to protect the public health by providing the Food and Drug Administration with certain authority to regulate tobacco products, to amend title 5, United States Code, to make certain modifications in the Thrift Savings Plan, the Civil Service Retirement System, and the Federal Employees' Retirement System, and for other purposes.

*Ordered further*, That the cloture vote on Amdt. No. 1247, offered by the Senator from Connecticut (Mr. Dodd), occur at 5:30 p.m. on Monday, June 8, 2009.

*Ordered further*, That the filing deadline for first degree amendments be 3:00 p.m. and for second degree amendments be 4:30 p.m. on Monday, June 8, 2009.

*Ordered further*, That with respect to the cloture motions filed on the bill and Amdt. No. 1247, the mandatory quorum calls under Rule XXII be waived. (*June 4, 2009.*)
