UNANIMOUS CONSENT AGREEMENT

HOUSE MESSAGE ON H.R. 4213

Ordered, That upon the conclusion of Morning Business on Thursday, June 17, 2010, the Senate resume consideration of the House message to accompany H.R. 4213, an act to amend the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to extend certain expiring provisions, and for other purposes; provided, that the Senate debate Amdt. No. 4333, to be reoffered by the Senator from South Dakota (Mr. Thune) with the same text; provided further, that the Senate debate the amendment for two hours, with the time equally divided and controlled between the Senator from Montana (Mr. Baucus) and the Senator from South Dakota (Mr. Thune), or their designees; further, that upon the use or yielding back of time, the Senator from Montana (Mr. Baucus) be recognized to raise a budget act point of order against the amendment; further, that the Senator from South Dakota (Mr. Thune), or his designee, be recognized to move to waive the applicable budget point of order; further, that if the waiver fails, then the amendment be withdrawn; further, that if the waiver for the Thune amendment succeeds, the amendment remains pending.

Ordered further, That with respect to the cloture motion filed on the motion to concur with Amdt. No. 4369 in the House amendment to the Senate amendment to H.R. 4213, the mandatory quorum required under Rule XXII be waived. (*June 15, 16, 2010.*)
