S. 126.	—To reduce the amount of financial assistance provided to the Government of Mexico in response to the illegal border crossings from Mexico into the United States, which serve to dissipate the political discontent with the higher unemployment rate within Mexico. Referred to Rules and Administration Jan. 25 (Legislative day of Jan. 5), 2011. Committee discharged Feb. 3, 2011. Referred to Foreign Relations Feb. 3, 2011.
