4.—*Ordered*, That with respect to the cloture motion filed on the motion to proceed to S. 1726, a bill to repeal the imposition of withholding on certain payments made to vendors by government entities, the mandatory quorum required under Rule XXII be waived. (*Oct. 19, 2011.*)
