UNANIMOUS CONSENT AGREEMENTS

S. 1789 (ORDER NO. 296)

1.—*Ordered*, That following Morning Business on Tuesday, April 17, 2012, the motion to proceed to the motion to reconsider the vote by which cloture was not invoked on the motion to proceed to S. 1789, a bill to improve, sustain, and transform the United States Postal Service, be agreed to; provided, that the motion to reconsider be agreed to, and the Senate resume consideration of the motion to invoke cloture on the motion to proceed to S. 1789, upon reconsideration; provided further, that there be up to 10 minutes of debate equally divided and controlled between the two Leaders, or their designees, on the motion to invoke cloture on the motion to proceed to S. 1789, upon reconsideration; further, that upon the use or yielding back of time, the Senate vote on the motion to invoke cloture on the motion to proceed to S. 1789, upon reconsideration.

Ordered further, That with respect to the cloture motion filed on the motion to proceed to S. 1789, the mandatory quorum required under Rule XXII be waived. (*Mar. 22, Apr. 16, 2012.*)

S. 1813

2.—*Ordered*, That S. 1813, a bill to reauthorize Federal-aid highway and highway safety construction programs, and for other purposes, as amended and passed, be held at the desk.

Ordered further, That when the Senate receives from the House a companion to S. 1813 (as determined by the two Leaders), it be in order for the Majority Leader to proceed to its immediate consideration, that all after the enacting clause be stricken and the text of S. 1813, as passed by the Senate be inserted in lieu thereof; provided, that the House bill, as amended, be read a third time, a statutory PAYGO statement be read (if necessary), the bill, as amended, be passed, and the motions to reconsider be considered made and laid upon the table; provided further, that upon passage, the Senate insist on its amendment, request a conference with the House on the disagreeing votes of the two Houses, and the Chair be authorized to appoint conferees on the part of the Senate.
