UNANIMOUS CONSENT AGREEMENTS

S. 3254 (ORDER NO. 419)

1.—*Ordered*, That following Leader remarks on Friday, November 30, 2012, the Senate resume consideration of S. 3254, an original bill to authorize appropriations for fiscal year 2013 for military activities of the Department of Defense, for military construction, and for defense activities of the Department of Energy, to prescribe military personnel strengths for such fiscal year, and for other purposes.

Ordered further, That the next first degree amendments in order be the following, and that at 9:30 a.m., on Friday, November 30, the Senate proceed to votes in relation to the amendments in the order listed and that there be two minutes equally divided prior to each vote; provided that no amendments be in order to any of the listed amendments prior to the vote:

- Cardin Amdt. No. 3025
- Menendez Amdt. No. 3232
- Nelson (FL) Amdt. No. 3073. (*Nov. 29, 2012.*)

S. 3525 (ORDER NO. 504)

2.—*Ordered*, That S. 3525, a bill to protect and enhance opportunities for recreational hunting, fishing, and shooting, and for other purposes, be returned to the Calendar status quo; provided, that at a time to be determined by the Majority Leader after consultation with the Republican Leader, it be in order for the Majority Leader to resume consideration of S. 3525. (*Nov. 26, 2012.*)

S. 3220 (ORDER NO. 410)

3.—*Ordered*, That with respect to the motion to invoke cloture on the motion to proceed to S. 3220, a bill to amend the Fair Labor Standards Act of 1938 to provide more effective remedies to victims of discrimination in the payment of wages on the basis of sex, and for other purposes, the mandatory quorum required under Rule XXII be waived. (*May 24, 2012.*)
