UNANIMOUS CONSENT AGREEMENT

S. 744 (ORDER NO. 80)

Ordered, That upon the conclusion of Morning Business on Tuesday, June 25, 2013, the Senate resume consideration of S. 744, a bill to provide for comprehensive immigration reform and for other purposes; provided, that the following amendments not be subject to modification or division and that no second degree amendments be in order to any of these amendments prior to votes in relation to the amendments:

- Boxer Amdt. No. 1240;
- Reed (RI) Amdt. No. 1224;
- Cruz Amdt. No. 1320.

Ordered further, That with respect to the cloture motions filed on S. 744 and the committee-reported substitute amendment to S. 744, the mandatory quorums required under Rule XXII be waived.

Ordered further, That all time during adjournment, recess, Morning Business, and Executive Session count post-cloture on Amdt. No. 1183, offered by the Senator from Vermont (Mr. Leahy), as modified.

Ordered further, That the filing deadline for second degree amendments to Amdt. No. 1183, as modified, be 4:00 p.m. on Monday.

Ordered further, That the filing deadline for first degree amendments to the committee-reported substitute amendment to S. 744 be 12:00 p.m. on Tuesday. (*June 18, 21, 24, 2013.*)
