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UNANIMOUS CONSENT AGREEMENTS

H.R. 1735 (ORDER NO. 99)

1.—*Ordered*, That on Thursday, June 4, 2015, following Leader Remarks, the Senate resume consideration of H.R. 1735, an Act to authorize appropriations for fiscal year 2016 for military activities of the Department of Defense, for military construction, and for defense activities of the Department of Energy, to prescribe military personnel strengths for such fiscal year, and for other purposes; provided, that there be 30 minutes equally divided in the usual form on Amendment No. 1522, offered by the Senator from Ohio, Mr. Portman, and Amendment No. 1540, offered by the Senator from Rhode Island, Mr. Reed (for Mr. Bennet); provided further, that upon the use or yielding of time, the Senate vote in relation to the amendments in the order listed and that no second degree amendments be in order prior to the votes.

Ordered further, That the regular order with respect to the following pending amendments to Amdt. No. 1463, offered by the Senator from Arizona (Mr. McCain), be as follows regardless of the order in which they were offered:

- McConnell Amdt. No. 1456;
- Reed Amdt. No. 1521;
- Portman Amdt. No. 1522;
- Reed (for Bennet) Amdt. No. 1540;
- Cornyn Amdt. No. 1486;
- Reed (for Shaheen) Amdt. No. 1494;
- Tillis Amdt. No. 1506.

S. 1357 (ORDER NO. 86)

2.—*Ordered*, That with respect to the motion to invoke cloture on the motion to proceed to S. 1357, a bill to extend authority relating to roving surveillance, access to business records, and individual terrorists as agents of foreign powers under the Foreign Intelligence Surveillance Act of 1978 until July 31, 2015, and for other purposes, the mandatory quorum under Rule XXII be waived. (*May 23, 2015.*)

S. 534 (ORDER NO. 22)

3.—*Ordered*, That with respect to the motion to invoke cloture on the motion to proceed to S. 534, a bill to prohibit funds from being used to carry out certain Executive actions related to immigration, and for other purposes, the mandatory quorum required under Rule XXII be waived. (*Feb. 27, 2015.*)
